Trustee Klapkowski directed the Clerk to read Ordinance #2016-08, Amending Sections 8-1-61 (B) and (C) of the Posen Village Code Regarding Possessions of Cannabis.

Attorney Murphy announced that the State had made changes to the Possession of Cannabis Act which are as follows:

Possession Prohibited: It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly possess cannabis in any amount of not more than ten (10.0) grams.

Penalty: Any person who violates this section shall be fined in the amount of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for each such offense.

This is in compliance with the State Statute and brings it in compliance with the total Ordinance on Cannabis.

Trustee Klapkowski moved, seconded by Trustee Torres to accept Ordinance #2016-08. All Trustees Voted Aye: motion was approved.

Trustee Klapkowski also announced that the National Night Out was a huge success and thanked all who attended.

President Schupek announced that he and Chief Doug Hoglund attended a seminar by Chicago Police Superintendent on Police Violence. He then turned the floor over to Chief Hoglund who gave a resume of what was discussed.
